How to Get Here

We are in Brewer Pilots Point Marina in Westbrook, CT, <http://byy.com>

From I-95 North: Exit 65, left onto CT Rte 153. Proceed 0.4 miles on Rte 153 and go right (South) on US Route 1.

Go through the traffic signal at the Dunkin Donuts. After another half mile or so the New Deal Steakhouse will be on your right. Look for the Custom Navigation Systems building on the left and enter the Pilots Point South yard. If you are asked, you are looking for slip #F-33. Follow the road past the pool until you see the large blue structure with the maroon awnings. Take a right at the main office and go around behind that building. You'll see the Sailing School boats all tied up together. We are down past them at the base of the gangway.

From I-95 South: Exit 65, right onto CT Rte 153. Follow the directions for I-95 North from this point.

From CT Route 9 South: Exit 3, straight to 2nd STOP sign, right on Route 153. Proceed to Route 1 and follow the above directions.

What to Bring

Sunscreen & motion sickness medications (if needed)! Ginger Ale works best for motion, we will have an ample supply aboard. Ask Steve about the "Seasick Patch Story". Loose, light colored clothing is good. The sun can get hot and the wind can get cool on Long Island Sound. Bring a pullover or sweatshirt and a hat. And don't forget the boat shoes. White soled sneakers will suffice and high heels are discouraged.

We will have soft drinks, beer and wine. There are several deli's nearby along Route 1.

What to Expect

Things are pretty sedate on the Sound in the summer, we will try to be back at the dock by 1700 hours (5PM). Expect a good time!
